THE TIEP METHOD

THE TIEP

CS...

- Read the chapter five times
- Use a bible without commentary notes
- Read straight through; try to understand general argument & central message
- If meaning remains obscure, try some different translations
- If you find it hard to concentrate, read aloud

1. CAPTION

Write your own short, descriptive title in 1-5 words. Use a key word you see in the text.

2. CONTENTS

Summarise the main points in sections, as the text naturally breaks.

3. CHIEF PEOPLE

Who are they? Why are they there? What is their significance?

4. CHOICE VERSE

Which verse is the key to the chapter, would you say?

5. CRUCIAL WORD(S)

What are the main nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs?

6. CHALLENGES

Write out any problems with meaning/interpretation.

7. CROSS REFERENCE

Look at related verses and passages.

8. CHRIST

What do you learn of Jesus' nature?
(Yes, in the OT too!
See Luke 24:27, 44)

9. CENTRAL LESSONS

What are the major principles and insights in this chapter?

10. CONCLUSION

Apply (how will this change you?)
Does the application help me become more like Jesus?
Memorise a key verse to reinforce the application.
