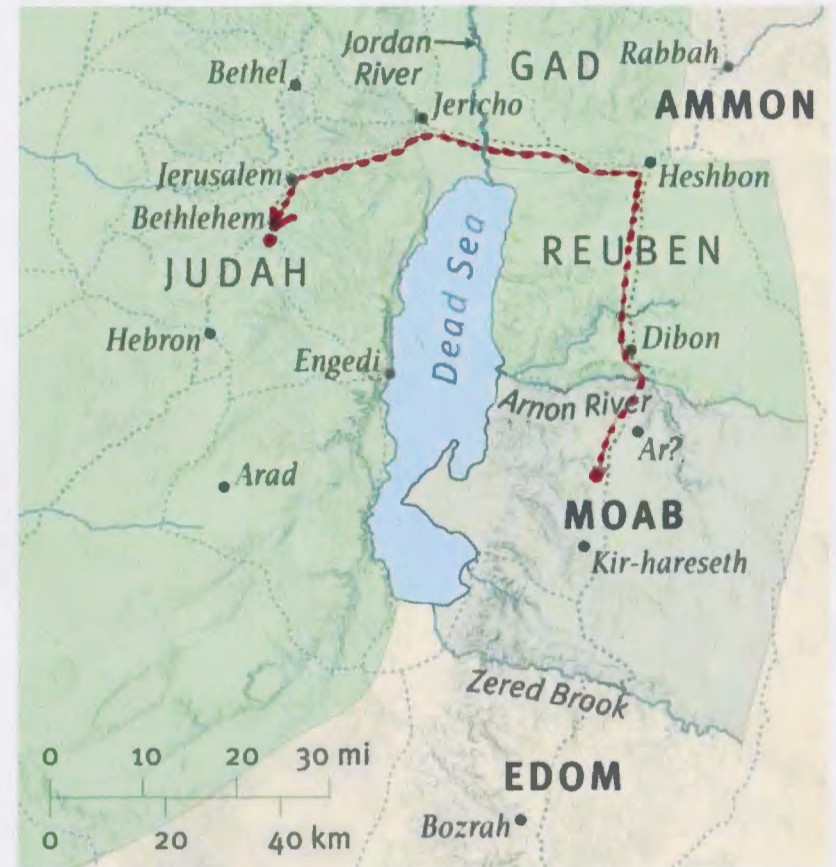

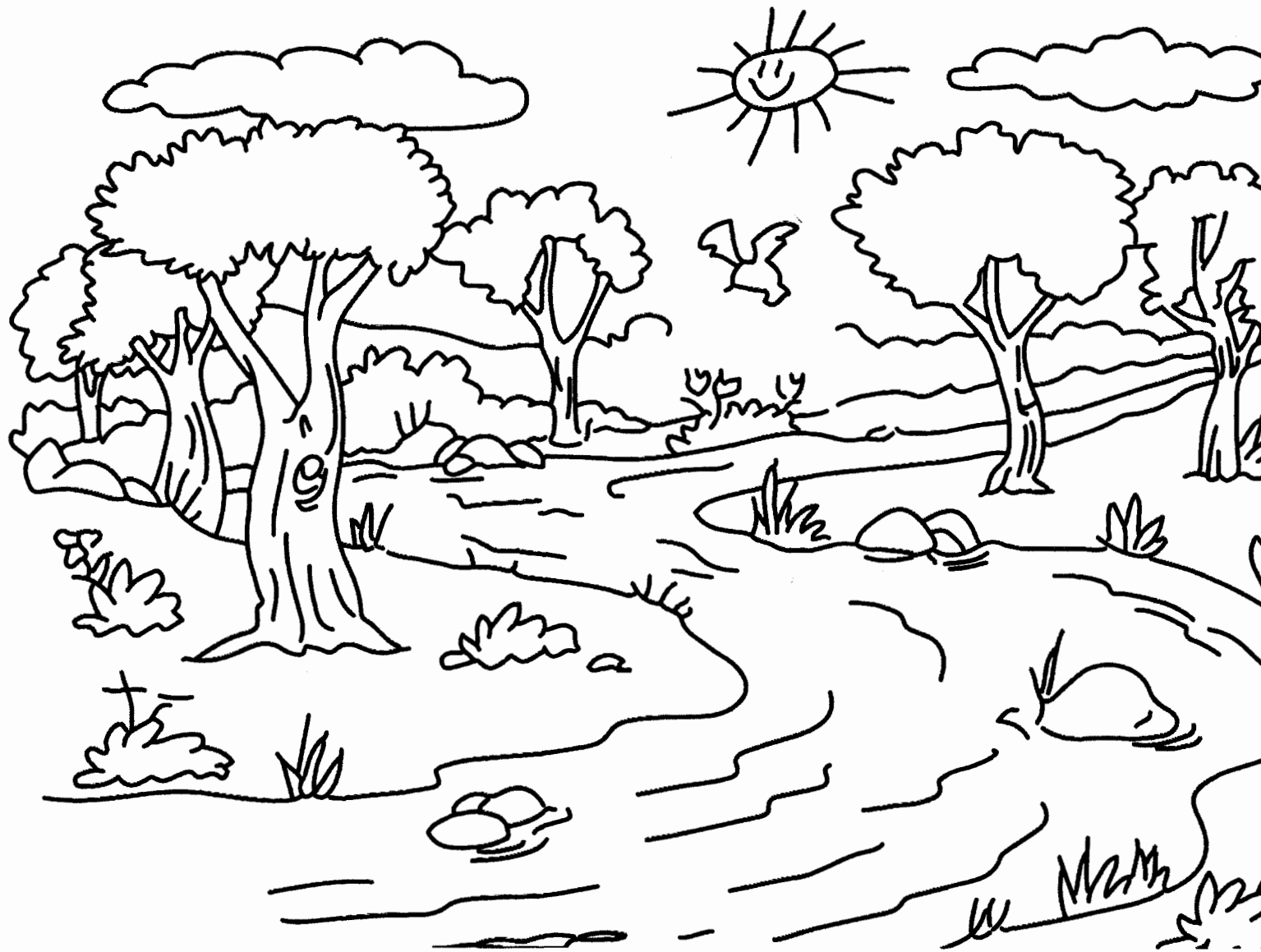

Why don't you use this page to draw some journeys you have taken. Maybe in a car or in a plane. By walking or on a bike?

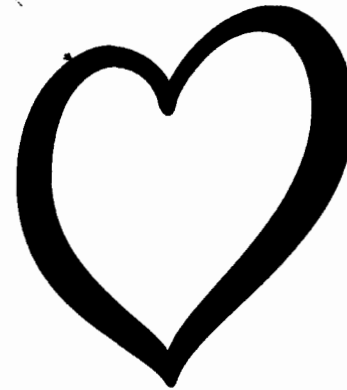
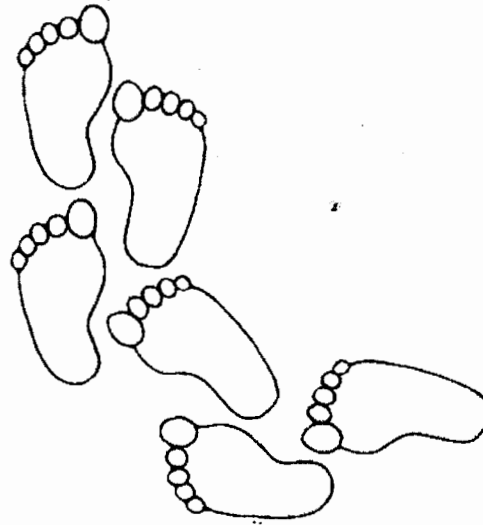
Use this page to add the cutouts from Ruth's story page to remind yourself of what happened to Ruth.
