Emma is a full-time mum, engaging in the communities around them and also caring for workers in their country through various roles.

Wavelength was set up in 2009 to draw together people in our area with a heart for the Arab World. Whether this was people who wanted to pray, had links to the region or had a desire to go there themselves.

Ben and Emma started it in their home when they got back from their travels in 2009 and realised that there were like-minded people in the area who would be encouraged by meeting together.

Forefront became their home church at that time and were prepared to support them in starting up the venture. Meetings were held at Tom and Ange's about three times a year when Ben and Emma moved abroad. Now they've moved, it will meet on **Saturday 13th July at David and Rhona's about 10.30am** for coffee, and at the end with a shared lunch.
