Thank you so much for standing with the team in prayer as we prepare for next week. It's great to think that the holiday club team is actually including all of you too, as you contribute to the work through prayer. Here's some ideas for how you can continue to pray for the club next week.

Monday: - We now have 44 children booked in, with the likelihood of a couple more before the start day. Please pray for the children to quickly settle in, and to be open to what God wants them to hear this week.

- Please also pray for the volunteers. We have a fab team from across the churches, including a handful of teenage helpers. Pray that we work well together, and that we show God's love through what we do and what we say.

- Pray particularly for the registration team today, signing children in and out, as the first day is normally the most hectic!

Tuesday: - Please pray for Andy, leading the main sessions each day, and the drama team who are also performing each day. Pray that these sessions engage each child who comes. The week is based on the life of Joseph in the Old Testament. Today we are looking at God being our helper, and how he helped Joseph when life got tough for him. Please pray for clarity in our communication of God's word each day through the different activities.

- Also, each day the children spend time in their small groups looking at the Bible story, discussing it, and doing crafts and other activities. Please pray for leaders and helpers to have good conversations with their group throughout the week and opportunities to share what God has done in their lives.

Wednesday: - Each day there are games sessions. Please pray for Lizzie and her helpers as they lead these. Pray for good weather so they can be outside, for safety and fun!

- Please pray for Anne and the catering team. Each day they are providing lunch for the children. Please also pray particularly that the team can get a clear idea of numbers they are catering for on Friday as early in the week as possible. Friday is when we will invite the families to join us too.

Thursday: - Today we are looking at how Joseph forgave his brothers, and how God forgives us through the death of Jesus. Pray for those for whom this will all be completely new, pray for revelation.

- Please continue to pray that both the volunteers and children will grow in faith through what they learn and experience this week.

- Also, please give thanks for the craft ladies, who have put in so much hard work ahead of the start of the week, to have things prepared for the groups each day.

Friday: - Please pray that the children's families will want to come to our end of week celebration, and that the children will enjoy sharing with them what they have learnt about God.

- Please also pray for good weather today, as we will follow the end of week celebration with a BBQ for the children and their families.

- Pray that children and families that we have met this week will get involved in other activities in the churches going on throughout the rest of the year.
